

ORGANIZATION MEMBERSHIP

Organization Membership

An organization member may be a specific facility type, such as a hospital, surgical center, clinic, long-term care facility, or may be an integrated organization that consists of multiple facilities. Any provider entity licensed or otherwise authorized under State law to provide health care services may become a member of NCPS. An organization member has a written agreement with NCPS outlining and documenting the relationship.

Reporting and Feedback

- Ability to report patient safety event information securely to NCPS. Reported information becomes protected and privileged under the Federal Patient Safety Rule.
- Access to organization-specific feedback and reports.
- De-identified events, patient safety alerts, reporting committee summaries, and improvement resources sent regularly to organization key contacts.
- Access to NCPS Annual Report.

Education
